

Expert Level Applied Report Examples

Example 1 – Page Spacing Management with Groups

One of the weaknesses in Crystal Reports is that when you have a group and the data set within the group exceeds a single page of the report, you don't have control of when the records break to form the second page. This example demonstrates one possible technique to help manage the page breaks.

Example 2 – Page Totals

This example uses the methods learned in the Example above to create Page Totals for your report

Example 3 – Arrays/Reading Data Into Arrays Dynamically

This topic teaches basic array concepts, and also discusses more advanced array concepts. The also discusses how to take data from your report and dynamically store it in an array.

Example 4 – Group Sorting and Arrays

This example builds on the concepts learned and applies them to a sorting example similar to how players are ranked in a Golf match.

This example demonstrates creation of advanced level custom functions
